5 bed capacity for primary care services

- The Letran Health Services Clinic is an Outpatient Care Facility designed to provide basic medical,
- dental in the form of
 - *preventive
 - *consultative, and
 - *curative services for the students, faculty members and personnel of the institution.

OBJECTIVE

To *promote*, *protect*, and *maintain* the health of the school population in order to attain the best state of well-being.



What are the MEDICAL BENEFITS of students?

- Annual Physical Examination (APE)
- Consultation with school physicians (GP, OB, Pedia)
- Over-the-counter medicines
- Minor medical and surgical emergency treatment Accident Insurance
- Health seminars
- Infirmary care

The clinic is open 13 hours a day, 6 days a week 7:00am to 8:00pm Monday to Saturday

What are the DENTAL BENEFITS of students?

- Consultation
- Over the counter (OTC) medicines
- Annual Oral Prophylaxis (once/year)
- Tooth extraction (twice per year)
- One (1) tooth restoration per semester
- Minor treatments at school clinic
- Dental seminar

*Should present parental consent for students 18 years old and below

STUDENT INSURANCE

PERSONAL ACCIDENT PROTECTION PLAN

Coverage:

- > 24 hours a day, in and out of the school premises
- While traveling in any public and private conveyance used for land, air and sea travel while traveling as a passenger on any commercial airline flights
- While the student is participating in any school sponsored social or non-social extra curricular activities including sports competition

INJURIES AS A RESULT OF THE FOLLOWING ARE NOT COVERED:

- Earthquake
- ·Tidal wave
- · Volcanic eruption
- Drowning
- · Dog bites
- · Snake bites
- ·Injuries resulting from violence





ACCIDENT MEDICAL INSURANCE

- Reimburses all the necessary medical expenses incurred for the treatment of the bodily injuries, hospital charges, doctor's fees, including cost of broken tooth due to the accident but not exceeding seven thousand pesos (Php 7,000)
- Excludes take home medications
- Documents Needed:
 - · Medical Certificate
 - Police Report (if available)
 - Official Receipt
 - Operative Procedure (if any)



OTHER BENEFITS:

PERMANENT DISABLEMENT (resulting from accident)

Pays up to 100% of the selected for loss by physical severance or total or permanent loss of the use of the part(s) of the insured's body as a result of an accident

ACCIDENTAL DEATH

Pays up to 100% of the amount selected for accidental loss of life within one year from the date of accident

BEREAVEMENT ASSISTANCE

Provides bereavement assistance in addition to all benefits payable under the plan in case of death within one year due to all causes

EXCLUSIONS:

- ➤ losses due to intentionally self-inflicted injury, suicide or any attempt threat while sane or insane, war, strikes, riot, civil commotion, war, rebellion or revolution
- while in the influence of prohibited drugs and illegal acts of the insured
